This Privacy Notice for PAI3 Labs Inc (doing business as PAI3) ("we," "us," or "our"), describes how and why we might access, collect, store, use, and/or share ("**process**") your information when you use our services ("**Services**"), including when you:

- When you use PAI3 Network which is a decentralized AI network that enables the training, publishing, and utilization of specialized AI models that can confidentially analyze user data to deliver personalized insights. AI model builders can access data and compute resources to publish specialized models.
- When you participate in the PAI3 Decentralized Autonomous Organization in any capacity
- When you become a member of worldwide PAI3 community via Telegram, Discord, LinkedIn, Facebook, Instagram or using any other community channel.
- When you earn PAI3 tokens by contributing data and or computing power to the PAI3 Network
- When you spend PAI3 tokens to run AI models.
- When you own a PAI3 Node, PAI3 node represents ownership and access rights to the decentralized PAI3 network.
- When you engage with us in other related ways, including any sales, marketing, or events

**Questions or concerns?** Reading this Privacy Notice will help you understand your privacy rights and choices. We are responsible for making decisions about how your information is processed. ### SUMMARY OF KEY POINTS

**How do we process your information?** We process your information to provide, improve, and administer our Services, communicate with you, for security and fraud prevention, and to comply with law. We may also process your information for other purposes with your consent. We process your information only when we have a valid legal reason to do so. We divide information into two categories – user information (arising from your use of Services) and sensitive information (information specific to you as a human being). Our policy clearly states how we process each of the two information categories

**What user information do we process?** When you visit, use, or navigate our Services, we may process user information depending on how you interact with us and the Services, the choices you make, and the products and features you use. We collect and store user information such as wallet address, IP address and Telegram address.

**In what situations and with which parties do we share user information?** We may share user information in specific situations and with specific third parties when required to improve our products or Services or for general business purposes.

**What sensitive information do we process?** When you visit, use, or navigate our Services, we may process sensitive information depending on how you interact with us and the Services, the choices you make, and the products and features you use. Some of the information may be considered "special" or "sensitive" in certain jurisdictions, for example your name, address, government issued unique identifiers, racial or ethnic origins, sexual orientation, and religious beliefs. We do not store any sensitive information.

**In what situations and with which parties do we share sensitive information?** We do not share sensitive information with third parties except when required by law.

**Do we sell any information to third parties?** We do not sell any information to third parties.

**How do we keep your information safe?** We have adequate organizational and technical processes and procedures in place to protect your information. However, no electronic transmission over the internet or information storage technology can be guaranteed to be 100% secure, so we cannot promise or guarantee that hackers, cybercriminals, or other unauthorized third parties will not be able to defeat our security and improperly collect, access, steal, or modify your information.

**What are your rights?** Depending on where you are located geographically, the applicable privacy law may mean you have certain rights regarding your information.

### 1. WHAT INFORMATION DO WE COLLECT?

#### Information you disclose to us

*In Short: We collect user information that you provide to us.*

We collect user information that you voluntarily provide to us when you express an interest in obtaining information about us or our products and Services, when you participate in activities on the Services, or otherwise when you contact us.

**User Information Provided by You.** The user information that we collect depends on the context of your interactions with us and the Services, the choices you make, and the products and features you use. The user information we collect may include the following:

- email addresses
- crypto / digital wallet address
- telegram usernames
- IP address

**Sensitive Information you disclose to us.** We do not store sensitive information. If such information is needed for delivery of a function or service, the information is discarded after the function or service has been delivered.

### 2. HOW DO WE PROCESS YOUR INFORMATION?

*In Short: We process your information to provide, improve, and administer our Services, communicate with you, for security and fraud prevention, and to comply with law. We may also process your information for other purposes with your consent.*

**We process your information for a variety of reasons, depending on how you interact with our Services, including:**

- **To deliver and facilitate delivery of services to the user.** We may process your information to provide you with the requested service.
- **To respond to user inquiries/offer support to users.** We may process your information to respond to your inquiries and solve any potential issues you might have with the requested service.

- **To send administrative information to you.** We may process your information to send you details about our products and services, changes to our terms and policies, and other similar information.
- **To fulfill and manage your orders.** We may process your information to fulfill and manage your orders, payments, returns, and exchanges made through the Services.
- **To protect our Services.** We may process your information as part of our efforts to keep our Services safe and secure, including fraud monitoring and prevention.
- **To save or protect an individual's vital interest.** We may process your information when necessary to save or protect an individual's vital interest, such as to prevent harm.

### 3. WHAT LEGAL BASES DO WE RELY ON TO PROCESS YOUR INFORMATION?

***In Short:** We only process your information when we believe it is necessary and we have a valid legal reason (i.e., legal basis) to do so under applicable law, like with your consent, to comply with laws, to provide you with services to enter into or fulfill our contractual obligations, to protect your rights, or to fulfill our legitimate business interests.*

***If you are located in the EU or UK, this section applies to you.***

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and UK GDPR require us to explain the valid legal bases we rely on in order to process your information. As such, we may rely on the following legal bases to process your information:

- **Consent.** We may process your information if you have given us permission (i.e., consent) to use your information for a specific purpose. You can withdraw your consent at any time. [Learn more about withdrawing your consent.](#)
- **Performance of a Contract.** We may process your information when we believe it is necessary to fulfill our contractual obligations to you, including providing our Services or at your request prior to entering into a contract with you.
- **Legitimate Interests.** We may process your information when we believe it is reasonably necessary to achieve our legitimate business interests and those interests do not outweigh your interests and fundamental rights and freedoms. For example, we may process your information for some of the purposes described in order to: Diagnose problems and/or prevent fraudulent activities.
- **Legal Obligations.** We may process your information where we believe it is necessary for compliance with our legal obligations, such as to cooperate with a law enforcement body or regulatory agency, exercise or defend our legal rights, or disclose your information as evidence in litigation in which we are involved.

- **Vital Interests.** We may process your information where we believe it is necessary to protect your vital interests or the vital interests of a third party, such as situations involving potential threats to the safety of any person.

*If you are located in Canada, this section applies to you.*

We may process your information if you have given us specific permission (i.e., express consent) to use your information for a specific purpose, or in situations where your permission can be inferred (i.e., implied consent). You can withdraw your consent at any time.

In some exceptional cases, we may be legally permitted under applicable law to process your information without your consent, including, for example:

- If collection is clearly in the interests of an individual and consent cannot be obtained in a timely way
- For investigations and fraud detection and prevention
- For business transactions provided certain conditions are met
- If it is contained in a witness statement and the collection is necessary to assess, process, or settle an insurance claim
- For identifying injured, ill, or deceased persons and communicating with next of kin
- If we have reasonable grounds to believe an individual has been, is, or may be victim of financial abuse
- If it is reasonable to expect collection and use with consent would compromise the availability or the accuracy of the information and the collection is reasonable for purposes related to investigating a breach of an agreement or a contravention of the laws of Canada or a province
- If disclosure is required to comply with a subpoena, warrant, court order, or rules of the court relating to the production of records
- If it was produced by an individual in the course of their employment, business, or profession and the collection is consistent with the purposes for which the information was produced
- If the collection is solely for journalistic, artistic, or literary purposes
- If the information is publicly available and is specified by the regulations

### 4. WHEN AND WITH WHOM DO WE SHARE YOUR USER INFORMATION?

**In Short:** We do not store or share your sensitive information with anyone, except when required by law. We may share user information in specific situations described in this section and/or with the following third parties.

- **Business Transfers.** We may share or transfer your user information in connection with, or during negotiations of, any merger, sale of company assets, financing, or acquisition of all or a portion of our business to another company.
- **Support and or Improve Product and or Services:** We may share your user information with specific 3<sup>rd</sup> parties for the purpose of improving our products and services and for the purpose of supporting you with the use of our product and services.

For activities specifically related to the issuance, distribution, and management of tokens, certain data may also be processed by PAI3 Network Ltd. (“Token Issuer”). The Token Issuer acts as a separate and independent controller with respect to those limited activities.

Accordingly:

- PAI3 Labs is the primary entity responsible for operating this website, providing development and platform services, and managing user interactions.
- Token Issuer may process data solely in connection with its token-related functions, such as compliance, token holder communications, and regulatory obligations.

We ensure appropriate measures are in place to safeguard your information and coordinate between PAI3 Labs and the Token Issuer where necessary.

### 5. HOW LONG DO WE KEEP YOUR INFORMATION?

**In Short:** We keep your information for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes outlined in this Privacy Notice unless otherwise required by law.

We will only keep your information for as long as it is necessary for the purposes set out in this Privacy Notice, unless a longer retention period is required or permitted by law (such as tax, accounting, or other legal requirements).

When we have no ongoing legitimate business need to process your information, we will either delete or anonymize such information, or, if this is not possible (for example, because your information has been stored in backup archives), then we will securely store your information and isolate it from any further processing until deletion is possible.

### 6. HOW DO WE KEEP YOUR INFORMATION SAFE?

***In Short:*** *We aim to protect your information through a system of organizational and technical security measures.*

We have implemented appropriate and reasonable technical and organizational security measures designed to protect the security of any information we process. However, despite our safeguards and efforts to secure your information, no electronic transmission over the Internet or information storage technology can be guaranteed to be 100% secure, so we cannot promise or guarantee that hackers, cybercriminals, or other unauthorized third parties will not be able to defeat our security and improperly collect, access, steal, or modify your information. Although we will do our best to protect your information, transmission of information to and from our Services is at your own risk. You should only access the Services within a secure environment.

### **7. DO WE COLLECT INFORMATION FROM MINORS?**

***In Short:*** *We do not knowingly collect data from or market to children under 18 years of age.*

We do not knowingly collect, solicit data from, or market to children under 18 years of age, nor do we knowingly sell such information. By using the Services, you represent that you are at least 18 or that you are the parent or guardian of such a minor and consent to such minor dependent's use of the Services. If we learn that information from users less than 18 years of age has been collected, we will deactivate the account and take reasonable measures to promptly delete such data from our records. ### **8. WHAT ARE YOUR PRIVACY RIGHTS?**

***In Short:*** *Depending on your state of residence in the US or in some regions, such as the European Economic Area (EEA), United Kingdom (UK), Switzerland, and Canada, you have rights that allow you greater access to and control over your information. You may review, change, or terminate your account at any time, depending on your country, province, or state of residence.*

In some regions (like the EEA, UK, Switzerland, and Canada), you have certain rights under applicable data protection laws. If you are located in Switzerland, you may contact the Federal Data Protection and Information Commissioner.

**Withdrawing your consent:** If we are relying on your consent to process your information, which may be express and/or implied consent depending on the applicable law, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time. You can withdraw your consent at any time by contacting us by using the contact details provided in the section "HOW CAN YOU CONTACT US ABOUT THIS NOTICE?" below or updating your preferences.

However, please note that this will not affect the lawfulness of the processing before its withdrawal nor, when applicable law allows, will it affect the processing of your information conducted in reliance on lawful processing grounds other than consent.

### 9. CONTROLS FOR DO-NOT-TRACK FEATURES

### **Request Verification**

Upon receiving your request, we will need to verify your identity to determine you are the same person about whom we have the information in our system. We will only use information provided in your request to verify your identity or authority to make the request. However, if we cannot verify your identity from the information already maintained by us, we may request that you provide additional information for the purposes of verifying your identity and for security or fraud-prevention purposes.

If you submit the request through an authorized agent, we may need to collect additional information to verify your identity before processing your request and the agent will need to provide a written and signed permission from you to submit such request on your behalf.

### **Appeals**

### **California "Shine The Light" Law**
